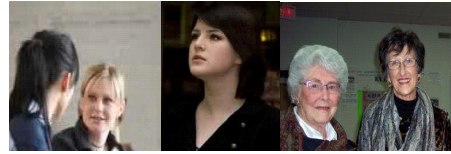


Canadian Federation of University Women founded in 1919 is a voluntary, non-profit, self-funded non-governmental organization of close to 10,000 women graduates, associates, and students in over 100 clubs in every province of Canada. CFUW members are active in public affairs to improve education, environment, peace, justice and human rights. They work together for equality for women and girls and to raise the social, economic, political and legal status of women.

CFUW/FCFDU is the largest of the member affiliates of the International Federation of University Women (IFUW). CFUW has special consultative status at the United Nations. CFUW BC Council's mandate is to encourage and initiate studies with respect to matters of provincial concern, consistent with CFUW goals. CFUW BC Council represents about 2000 members in 23 clubs in British Columbia



What We Do

- Distribute over \$200,000 annually in support of education for women.
- Advocate annually with provincial government and submit briefs on:
 - provincial budget priorities
 - pension reform and legal aid
- Active in child care and early learning issues through our BC Council Committee on Child Care
- Work collaboratively with other women's and community groups

Clubs also offer a wide variety of programs and activities such as:- *Reading groups, bridge, hiking, films, concerts and theatre, dining, conversational issues.*
